Up-date from School

The Local Authority have erected an out-door canopy as a replacement for the old canopy. This is sited on the grass area between the KS2 and Foundation Phase Yards so that access is easy for all children. This will be known as the Snack Shak area. This is not currently in use as we are waiting for appropriate flooring to be installed.

The Eco Committee and School Council have chosen and ordered out door games for the Snack Shak Area also raised beds, tables, benches and other resources. These items are being purchased using money from a grant from Bron Afon and the Tesco Bags to School grant.

Now that the building works have been completed the School Council have organised a company to paint new markings on the Foundation Phase Yard using funds from a Community Grant.

School is very grateful to the PTA for their ongoing support with fund raising.

Up-date from PTA

Events so far this year have raised almost £2000 ! PTA have secured some grant funding - Bron Afon have granted £500 to be used on the central courtyard area, and Jon Horler (councillor/ governor) has recently donated £200.

PTA are planning to apply for a large grant to replace the old climbing frame. We would like to replace it with something more long-lasting, which will be expensive! Approximately £10-15,000
