

<p>Handwriting - practise forming all of your letters correctly. Make sure you start in the right place and use the lines in the right way. You could use your words to play pairs, complete word hunts in the house, for example. Choose no more than 6 unknown words. Don't forget to keep practising the ones that you already know or learn.</p> <p>(Sheet to support)</p>	<p>Sentence writing - practise writing sentences. Remember to use capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. You could write about a picture, or an object, or something that you have been doing.</p>	<p>Spelling - use the HFW word sheet to practise spelling tricky words. Remember you could do rainbow writing, you could write them in mud or shaving foam. Choose 3 words to work on at a time.</p> <p>(sheet to support)</p>
<p>Keep a diary of the books that you read. Write a review to share with others.
