Parent/Carer information - 3rd February 2021

Dear parents/carers,

Thank you for the great job you are all doing in supporting our children with home learning as well as juggling all the other roles you have. We are very proud of our children and the work that has been completed since January. Online learning presents many challenges. Staff are only a message away if you need support. Don't feel the pressure to do more than you are able to.

As you may know, the First Minister has announced Welsh Government's intention to return more children to school 'starting with the very youngest children in primary schools for face to face teaching from Monday 22nd February'. This is obviously subject to the Covid infection rates continuing to fall. We have no further information at present and I will update you on the details as soon as they are available.

As a school we are trying to run our school safely as a hub for children of key workers and vulnerable learners, whilst adhering to the Welsh Government guidance of supporting staff to work from home where possible. By doing this we aim to reduce the risk of transmission of the virus. We have had many requests from parent/carers for their children to attend our keyworker/ vulnerable learner hub who are not eligible. Please remember that children are safest at home and hubs are for essential care only so we may need to refuse your request as places are limited. We must follow the guidance and limit the amount of staff and pupils in school. Our main concern is keeping everyone safe.

We understand that these are very challenging times for all families and are happy to discuss any individual concerns with you.
