Rights' Respecting Schools Rights of the month (linked to anti-bullying week)

Article 2 - Non-discrimination The Convention applies to every child without discrimination, whatever their ethnicity, gender, religion, language, abilities or any other status, whatever they think or say, whatever their family background.

Article 12 - Respect for the views of the child Every child has the right to express their views, feelings and wishes in all matters affecting them, and to have their views considered and taken seriously. This right always applies, for example during immigration proceedings, housing decisions or the child's day-to-day home life.

Article 19 - Protection from violence, abuse and neglect Governments must do all they can to ensure that children are protected from all forms of violence, abuse, neglect and bad treatment by their parents or anyone else who looks after them.

COVID-19 procedures in school

Thank you for your cooperation with our continued measures in place to limit the spread of Covid-19 since the beginning of this autumn term. When we return after the half term break we will remain cautious in our approach and continue with the following:

- The one-way system into school in the morning.
- Classes sitting in class bubbles for breakfast club and lunch.
- Minimal mixing of classes in school.
- Continuation of virtual assemblies and assemblies in hall only where classes can be spaced safely.
- Parent Teacher Consultations will be virtual.
- All staff will continue with twice weekly lateral flow testing
- Pupils will be encouraged to wash their hands/use hand sanitiser on a regular basis.
