GRANT FUNDING – up to £125 per child

If you are on low income and receive benefits (see list below) you are also eligible for a grant. This applies to each of your children from Reception to Year 6 and could be up to value of £125 per child!

If you are in receipt of any of these benefits you will be eligible for this grant:

- Income Support
- Income based job seekers allowance
- Child Tax Credit with an annual income less than £16,190 (you are not entitled if you also receive Working Tax Credit)
- Income-related Employment Support allowance
- The guarantee element of state pension credit
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Universal Credit (where the monthly net earned income is not more than £616.67)
